Letter from Dr. V:

At the recent Ohio Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics Annual Meeting we unveiled a new resource for MOBI in regard to parental refusal of vaccines. A set of three brochures, which address the importance of vaccines and recent parental concerns, were produced thanks to a Healthy People 2010 grant received from national AAP. The three pamphlets progress from thanking and encouraging parents who vaccinate their child on the recommended schedule to warning parents of the severe consequences of delaying or refusing vaccination of their children. These brochures have been extensively discussed, reworked, and modified by the project team and focus groups. I would like to thank everyone who gave their time and input for this project, especially Elizabeth Kelleher, project manager.

I hope that with the parental refusal form included in the Office Resource Pack two years ago, and now the brochures, physicians and practices dealing with parental delay or refusal of appropriate vaccinations will have adequate resource information to distribute.

In discussing this resource during a MOBI presentation, please stress that parents in our focus groups found the brochures to be *most effective* when presented and promoted by the **physician** rather than another staff member. A strong endorsement for vaccination by a child's physician was the most effective method of convincing a parent to vaccinate their child.

I would like to thank all of you who wrote letters of support for our recent funding renewal application. Just this week, we learned that the MOBI grant has been **approved** by the Ohio Department of Health for another year! We should hear from the Centers for Disease Control regarding funding in the next month. I can't imagine a more dedicated and effective group of people in the state of Ohio working for the health of Ohio's children. Thank you for your continued time and talents. Ohio AAP addresses parental refusal of vaccines with new brochures - Awarded a Healthy People 2010 grant from National AAP, the Ohio AAP developed a set of three brochures for physicians to distribute to the parents/guardians during the office visit when vaccines are discussed or administered. The brochures are supplemental information designed to help the physician streamline the vaccine discussion during the office visit.

The brochures target three groups - parents who follow the immunization schedule; parents who choose to delay the schedule; and parents who refuse to vaccinate their children. The brochures are as follows:

Your Child Thanks You. (For parents who follow the schedule)

This brochure is meant to be reassurance that the parent made the RIGHT choice for their child. This brochure also addresses adolescent vaccines and other anticipatory guidance.

Make an Educated Choice. (For parents who choose to delay the schedule)

This brochure provides supporting information on the importance of not delaying vaccines.

What is your reason? (For parents who refuse to vaccinate)

This brochure provides information that will support the physician's advice on vaccine refusal.

In January 2011, one of each of the brochures (in black and white and a 4-color version) will be included in the MOBI Office Resource pack, as an additional resource for providers. News You Can Use:

The 2011 CDC Recommended Childhood and Adolescent Immunization Schedule - "Recommended Immunization Schedules for Persons Aged 0 Through 18 Years United States 2011, will not be published in *MMWR* until Feb. 11, 2011. Normally released in January, the CDC has decided to postpone the release of this next year's schedule until February and this move is considered to be permanent. The reason for this move is to allow adequate time for the CDC to approve recommendations ACIP votes on during its late-October meeting and to incorporate those recommendations into the immunization schedules for the following year. The Adult Immunization Schedule-United States 2011 is scheduled to be released on February 4, 2011.
