

NURSE EDUCATOR

The *Ohio Chapter, American Academy of Pediatrics (Ohio AAP)* is seeking a Registered Nurse to work on an established immunization program for a contracted period of April 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018. The nurse educator would be responsible for the following:

GENERAL JOB DUTIES

- Attend trainings for Maximizing Office Based Immunization (MOBI), Teen Immunization Education Sessions (TIES) and Assessment-eXchange-Feedback-Incentives (AFIX).
- Schedule and conduct 30 MOBI programs, 30 TIES programs and 30 AFIX assessments in targeted counties.
- Spend 8 hours a week at the Ohio AAP office in Columbus conducting administrative duties including planning and scheduling programs via phone, email and fax, conducting follow-up surveys, gathering and preparing materials for programs.
- Maintain working database of locations, manner of contact and marketing techniques.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Immunization experience required
- MOBI, TIES and AFIX experience preferred
- Currently licensed as a Registered Nurse in the state of Ohio
- Reliable transportation

COMPENSATION - \$30,600 plus mileage

This is a part-time position based on grant funding available April 2017 – June 2018. The nurse educator will be paid for hours spent in the Ohio AAP office and per program completed.

This position requires the nurse educator to drive to training location. Mileage will be reimbursed at the current state level of \$0.52 per mile.

PROGRAM DETAILS

The *Ohio Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics* promotes the health, safety and well being of children and adolescents so they may reach their full potential. The Ohio AAP will accomplish this by addressing the needs of children, their families, and their communities, and by supporting Chapter members through advocacy, education, research, service, and improving the systems through which they deliver pediatric care.

The *Maximizing Office Based Immunization (MOBI) program* has been in existence since 1996. MOBI nurse educators are trained by state and nationwide vaccine experts on childhood vaccines. The trainers travel to pediatric and family practices and health departments provide a one-hour continuing education presentation on techniques to improve immunization rates.

The *Teen Immunization Education Sessions (TIES)* program has been in existence since 2014. TIES nurse educators are trained by state and nationwide vaccine experts on adolescent vaccines. The trainers travel to pediatric and family practices and health departments and provide a one-hour continuing education presentation on techniques to improve immunization rates.

Assessment-eXchange-Feedback-Incentives (AFIX) is a quality improvement tool that measures immunization coverage levels developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and managed by the Ohio Department of Health.
